1. The **Jesuits** were the band of priests and religious brothers who gathered around Saint Ignatius and grew into the Society of Jesus.
2. **Reform** means “to regain something that has been lost or reshape something that has become disfigured.”
3. The will to give oneself completely to God is called **devotion**.
4. **Protestantism** is the system of faith and worship that arose in the sixteenth century that either rejected or sought to change many Church beliefs and traditions.
5. The **laity** is the term given to the baptized faithful who serve the Church in the world and are not ordained through Holy Orders or called to the religious life.
6. Someone who participates in the Church’s mission of evangelization by proclaiming the Gospel and witnessing the truth and love of God to others is a **missionary**.
