

Rosary during Adoration

The Second Joyful Mystery: The Visitation. “Mary arose and went with haste into the hill country, to a city of Judah, and she entered the house of Zechariah and greeted Elizabeth” (Luke 1:39–40). *Our Father . . .*

1. “When Elizabeth heard the greeting of Mary, the child leaped in her womb” (1:41). *Hail Mary . . .*
2. John the Baptist recognized Your presence, Jesus, and leaped. You are truly present in the Eucharist before us now. Deepen our faith in this reality so that we can adore You as we ought. *Hail Mary . . .*
3. “Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit, and she exclaimed with a loud cry, ‘Blessed are you among women’” (1:41–42). *Hail Mary . . .*
4. Mary, you are indeed blessed among women because of your obedience to God. Show us how to imitate your obedience so that we may obey your Son, Jesus, whom we adore and love. *Hail Mary . . .*
5. Elizabeth continued, “Blessed is the fruit of your womb!” (1:42). *Hail Mary . . .*
6. Lord Jesus, You are the fruit of the Blessed Virgin’s womb. Thank You for becoming human in order to save us from sin and death. Thank you for being here with us now. *Hail Mary . . .*
7. Elizabeth said, “And why is this granted me, that the mother of my Lord should come to me?” (1:43). *Hail Mary . . .*
8. Like Elizabeth, we are in awe that You, Lord Jesus Christ, have come to us to show us God’s love and mercy. You lovingly show us Your presence in the Holy Eucharist. *Hail Mary . . .*
9. Elizabeth said, “For behold, when the voice of your greeting came to my ears, the child in my womb leaped for joy” (1:44). *Hail Mary . . .*
10. Jesus, You brought joy to Saint John the Baptist in Elizabeth’s womb. Give us hearts that rejoice in Your loving presence. Lead us to bring Your joy to all we encounter. *Hail Mary . . .*
