Chapter 3

Lesson Enhancement Video: The Annunciation

- Start with the teaching point of the video: What did we hear about in the video? (The Annunciation.)
 - Why is the Annunciation a significant event in salvation history? (Answers may include because
 an angel appeared to Mary, because Mary said yes to God's plan, and because this moment was the
 beginning of Christ's time here on earth.)
 - Which angel appeared to Mary? (Gabriel.)
- Invite students to reflect on what they've seen and heard in the video: You have all heard about the Annunciation before, but what aspect of these events stood out to you? (Answers may include Mary's confusion, her young age, her bravery, and how shocking it would be to have an angel appear to you.)
 - In the video, Peter, the narrator, asks us how we would respond if an angel appeared to us. What
 would you do? (Pause.) Would you be scared or confused? (Answers may vary.) This is a moment to
 help the students enter into Mary's shoes to appreciate her response more fully.
 - How did Mary respond to Gabriel's message? (Answers may include bravely, obediently, and lovingly. She asked how this would happen and accepted Gabriel's message, saying, "Let it be to me according to your word" [Luke 1:38].)
- Deepen the teaching point of the video: Who was Mary before the Annunciation? (A holy girl from a small town called Nazareth.)
 - Who did she become after the Annunciation? (The Mother of God and of all Christians.)
 - How did she become the Mother of God? (Through the power of the Holy Spirit and by accepting God's grace. Through her love, obedience, and bravery, she allowed God to work through her.)
 - Through her response, what does Mary teach us? (Like her, we must lovingly, obediently, and bravely accept God's plan for our lives. We must humbly accept His grace and seek to do His will alone.)
