## **Chapter 4**

## **Lesson Enhancement Video: God's Presence**

- Start with the teaching point of the video: In the video, Joe talked about being present. What does it mean to be present? (Answers may include being there and giving of yourself at a particular place and time. I am present if I am with you.)
  - What example did Joe use to explain presence? (When teachers or coaches take attendance and ask who is present, either in class or on the field.)
- Develop the teaching point of the video: Joe pointed out that we can be present with our friends in different ways. What are some of these ways? (Answers may include physically present, virtually present, audibly present, and even present through pictures and images.)
  - Likewise, he said God is present to us in many different ways. What are some of these ways?
     (Through sacred images, in other baptized people, through the sacraments, and most especially in the Eucharist.)
  - In what way is God present to us in the Eucharist? (He is truly present in His Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity.)
- Invite students to reflect on what they have learned: How should we treat our friends when they are present to us? (With kindness and respect.)
  - Would it be hurtful if somebody came up to your friend and insulted him? (Of course.) What
    about if someone took a picture of your friend and stomped on it? (Yes, it would be hurtful!)
  - Similarly, if God is present through sacred objects, how should we treat them? (Answers may include with care and respect.)
  - How should we treat the Eucharist, which is Jesus' Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity? (We should treat the Eucharist with extra care by consuming it reverently.)
