Chapter Summary

The Chosen People, Israel, became slaves in Egypt under a very cruel pharaoh. Moses' life was spared by God so that he could answer the call to deliver the Israelites from slavery and bring them back to the Promised Land. After hearing God's call from the burning bush, Moses obeyed God. Moses confronted Pharaoh many times, asking him to let God's people go, but Pharaoh obstinately refused. God sent ten plagues on Egypt before Pharaoh was convinced to give in. The final plague, the death of the firstborn, was coupled with the institution of the Passover Feast. Through the Passover, God spared His Chosen People from the effects of the plague. After this final calamity, Pharaoh relented and the Israelites were free once more.

More for Parents
