

God's Greatest Commandments Triptych

Materials:

- Pattern is on the catechist portal; one per student
- Tape
- Scissors

Have the students cut out their patterns. Then have them lay the “Love God with all your heart” tablet on top of the tablet with the first three commandments and tape along the left edge. Then have them lay the “Love your neighbor as yourself” tablet on top of the tablet with the last seven commandments and tape along the right edge.

As they open up their tablets, explain how the two parts of Jesus’ Great Commandment cover all the commandments given to Moses in the Old Testament!
