God Keeps His Promises Rainbow Craft

Materials:

- Pattern is on the catechist portal; one per student
- Cotton balls; five per student
- Construction paper (red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple); one $\frac{3}{4}$ " × $8\frac{1}{2}$ " strip in each color per student
- Glue
- String; 3-inch piece per student
- Scissors
- Tape

The students will be making a rainbow hanging as you review the promise God made after the Flood.

Have the students cut out their cloud patterns. Pass about five cotton balls to each student and have them stretch out the cotton balls and glue them over the cloud. Then pass out the six colored strips of construction paper and have them tape the top edge of each strip along the bottom edge of the back of their clouds. Finally, to form the hanger, have them tape the string, in a loop, to the top of the cloud.

Ask the students to find a special place to hang their rainbows as a reminder that God keeps His promises!
