

A New Heart and Spirit

Materials:

This reflection will help students understand that through Jesus, we are transformed into new creations.

Read the Scripture verse on page 91 of the Student Text. In the Old Testament, God promised to give us new hearts and new spirits. Have the students fill in the blanks to complete the Scripture verse from the Old Testament.
