Chapter 4

Lesson Enhancement Video: Part of God's Family

- Start with the teaching point of the video: In this video, we learned about the many covenants God made with His people. What is a covenant? (A special promise or a sacred bond that God makes with His people.)
 - What makes the covenant a special promise? (It is holy, or sacred; it is a promise between us and God.)
 - In general, what does God promise in a covenant? (He promises to love and care for us.)
 - In general, what do we need to do when we are in a covenant with God? (We must love and obey Him in return.)
- Develop the teaching point of the video: Can you name some of the people God made covenants with? (Answers may include Adam and Eve, Noah, Abraham, Moses, David, and us.)
 - What did God specifically promise in His covenant with Adam and Eve? (That He would send a Savior, Jesus.)
 - What did God specifically promise in His covenant with Noah? (That He would never flood the earth again.)
 - What did God specifically promise in His covenant with Abraham? (That his descendants would be more numerous than the stars in the sky and that He would give his descendants the Promised Land.)
 - What did God specifically promise in His covenant with Moses? (That He would take care of His Chosen People and lead them back to the Promised Land.)
 - What did God specifically promise in His covenant with David? (That his kingdom would last forever.)
- Make the video more personal: What is the last and greatest covenant? (The New Covenant of love.)
 - Who is the New Covenant made between? (God and each of us individually.)
 - What do we need to do? (Love God with all our hearts, minds, and souls.)
 - What does God promise? (That He will care for us and bring us into friendship with Him now and forever in Heaven.)
 - When we enter into this covenant, what family do we join? (We join God's family. We are sons and daughters
 of God.)

Gabriel's Quest for Chapter 4: The Invitation

Lesson Link: God asked Abraham to make sacrifices in his life. These sacrifices showed Abraham's faith in God and strengthened his faith in God. Gabriel is faced with a sacrifice that is hard to make. He learns the importance of such sacrifices.

- What choice did Gabriel make? (He sacrificed talking with his dad to go to the party.)
- Was Gabriel happy with his decision? Why? (No. He missed seeing his dad and didn't know when he would see him again.)
- · Have you ever had to choose between two choices? How did you decide? (Answers may vary.)
- Optional: Have students use their journal pages to reflect on Question 3: *Have you ever had to choose between two choices? How did you decide?* Journal pages are available on the catechist and student portals.
