1. The **human soul** is the nonphysical or spiritual dimension of a human being.
2. A particular act which is always wrong to choose is an **intrinsic evil**.
3. An **Apostle** is one of Jesus' twelve closest followers whom he sent to carry out his mission.
4. **Redemptive suffering** occurs when we freely unite our suffering with Christ's and allow him to bring about good for ourselves and for others through that suffering.
5. **Sanctifying grace** is the free gift of God's own life, poured into our souls by the Holy Spirit, that heals us and makes us holy.
6. Being in the **image of God** means we share with God the powers of intellect and will.
7. The **Beatitudes** are Jesus' teachings about how to attain happiness in this life and in Heaven.
8. **Mortal sin** destroys charity and completely separates us from God.
9. Faith, hope, and charity are the **theological virtues**.
