Lesson Enhancement Video: The Liturgical Year

- Start with personal experience: What is your favorite season—spring, summer, fall, or winter? (Answers may vary.)
 - Why is it your favorite season? (Answers may vary.)
 - Did you know that there are seasons in the Church? (Answers may vary.)
- Highlight the teaching point of the video: These seasons are called liturgical seasons. We just learned about some of the liturgical seasons in this video. *Can you name any?* (Answers may include Ordinary Time, Advent, Christmas, Lent, and Easter.)
 - Each of these seasons has a different color. What is the color for Advent and Lent? (Purple.)
 - What is the color for Ordinary Time? (Green.)
 - Throughout the year, we also celebrate saints' feast days. Who is your favorite saint? (Answers may vary.) This is an
 opportunity to encourage the students to look up the feast days of their favorite saints.
- End by personalizing the video: *Why do we have liturgical seasons that make up the Church's liturgical calendar?* (To show that God has entered time and makes it holy.)
 - *What is your favorite liturgical season and why?* (Answers may include Advent, when we prepare for Christmas; Lent, when we prepare for Easter; Christmas; and Easter.)
