Lesson Enhancement Video: Our Response to God's Call

- Start with personal experience: What do you do before you have a friend over to visit? (Answers may include pick up my toys, sweep the floors, or tidy the house.)
 - Why do you clean the house before someone comes over? (Answers may include because I want to make things look nice for my friend and I want my friend to feel welcome.)
 - In the video, what was the little girl doing? (Cleaning the house.)
 - Why was she doing this? (Because she was eagerly waiting for Jesus to come and visit her.)
- Highlight the teaching point of the video: The little girl is showing us that when Christ knocks on the door of our houses, we, too, should make sure things are cleaned up in our hearts and souls.
 - What are some ways we can remove distractions and the mess our sin has made? (Answers may vary.)
 - One way we can remove distractions so that we hear Jesus knocking is to find a quiet place to pray every day. What is a place in your house where you can quietly pray to Jesus? (Answers may include bedroom, outside, and office.)
 - One way we can clean up the mess of sin is by receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation. When was the last time you received this sacrament? (Answers may vary.) Remind the students when this sacrament is offered at your parish so that they can encourage their parents to take them.
- Provide peace and encouragement: *If we make our hearts ready for Christ and open the door when He knocks, what do you think we will receive?* (*His love and peace beyond all human understanding.*)
 - This is a good time to tell an age-appropriate story of a time when you found peace in God's presence in your life.
