Lesson Enhancement Video: The Pattern of Virtue and Vice

- Start with the teaching point of the video: *In this video, we learn about patterns. What are some of the examples of a natural pattern given in the video?* (A snowflake, the rings of a tree, a seashell, or a spiderweb. A pattern refers to something that is repeated.)
 - **Can you give any other examples of a pattern?** (Answers may include the tiles on a floor or ceiling, the stripes on a sweater, or the flower details on a dress.)
 - What pattern does Clyde point out in this video? (A spiderweb.)
- Develop the teaching point of the video: What happens if an insect tries to fly into a spiderweb? (It becomes trapped.)
 - Similarly, we can create bad behavior patterns. *Does anyone know how we make bad patterns?* (By committing the same sin over and over.)
 - What is a bad pattern of our actions called? (Vice.)
 - What can happen if we create a bad pattern of vice? (We can become trapped like a fly in a web.)
- Finish by relating the video to the students' lives: Have you ever developed a bad habit or vice? (Pause.)
 - Do you find that you commit the same sin over and over again? (Answers may vary.)
 - If so, then you may be fighting a vice. But don't fear! With God's grace and our repeated action, we can escape any vice. What are some ways we can receive God's grace? (Praying, receiving the Eucharist reverently, and receiving God's forgiveness in the Sacrament of Reconciliation.)
 - You can challenge the students to pick one way they can begin to overcome any patterns of sin in their lives.
