Creation to Joshua

Some, if not all, of the following information must be depicted or stated on the posters for each of the events:

Creation:

- Summary: Water flowed out of Eden and split into rivers to give life and fruitfulness to creation. The Holy Spirit moved over the waters at Creation.
- Foreshadowing: The waters of Baptism bring spiritual life and fruitfulness.

The Flood:

- Summary: The waters of the Flood cleansed the earth of sin and evil. God saved Noah and his family in the ark.
- Foreshadowing: The waters of Baptism cleanse us from Original Sin/sin.

Crossing the Red Sea

- Summary: God parted the Red Sea for the Israelites to cross safely. He closed the Red Sea over the evil Egyptians to save the Israelites from slavery and death.
- Foreshadowing: The waters of Baptism save us from death/sin. We have victory over our enemies.

The Waters at Marah

- Summary: God made the bitter waters at Marah sweet by having Moses throw the wood of a certain tree into it. The Israelites didn't die from thirst in the wilderness.
- Foreshadowing: The waters of Baptism save us from death.

Crossing the Jordan River

- Summary: Joshua led the Israelites across the Jordan River and into the Promised Land. God stopped the waters so that they could cross.
- Foreshadowing: The waters of Baptism lead us to victory over our enemies (sin and death).
