Lesson 1: Throughout the Old Testament, God worked through water to save His people. In the New Testament, Jesus prepared Nicodemus to understand that the Kingdom of God is a spiritual kingdom and that we need water and the Spirit to enter this kingdom. How does this explain the need for Baptism?

Answers may include that Jesus was saying that because we need the Holy Spirit to enter the kingdom, we must receive the Spirit through the waters of Baptism.

Lesson 2: Baptism brings about real changes in us. We are washed of all sin. We are members of the Body of Christ. We are God’s adopted children, and we are in friendship with God. How do these changes help you live with the peace and joy of the Holy Spirit in your heart now and one day in the Kingdom of God in Heaven?

Answers may include that I cannot live with the peace and joy of the Holy Spirit now or in Heaven unless I become a new creation by first being washed of all sin. As a member of the Body of Christ, the Church, I will grow in God’s family by receiving other sacraments that will strengthen me in grace and virtue. As God’s child, I will love and obey Him above all things. By being in friendship with God, I receive the grace I need to live as His child now and forever.

Lesson 3: In Baptism, we receive the light of Christ, which destroys the darkness of sin and evil. What is a way you can follow the light of Christ in your life?

Answers may include I can read the Word of God to know Christ’s truth. I can obey God’s laws to know what to do. I can listen to people who know how to follow Christ. I can pray and ask for more grace to follow Jesus. I can live with the theological virtues of faith, hope, and love so that I can always trust God first and love like Him.

Lesson 4: Baptism (through the sacrament, blood, or desire) is necessary for salvation. How does this truth encourage you to share the Good News of Jesus with others?

Answers may include because Baptism is necessary to enter the Kingdom of God (even if by blood or desire), then it is important that everyone hears about Jesus. We are created to be in communion with God in Heaven, yet not all recognize this longing within themselves. They often seek other things, so I must share how much Jesus loves us and is calling everyone to be part of His kingdom now and in Heaven.
