<b>Lesson 1:</b> Jesus perfectly fulfilled the prophecies and the laws given by God to Moses. "For the law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ" (John 1:17). According to this Scripture verse, why weren't the people of the Old Testament able to fully follow God's laws given to them by Moses?
