Chapter Summary

God chose prophets, such as Elijah, Micah, and Isaiah, to speak to the people on His behalf and prepare them for the Messiah. The prophets also taught God's Law to the people and called them to turn from their sin. These prophets called the people to conversion and prophesied about the coming of the Messiah, or the Christ, who would reconcile the people to God. The people waited for the Messiah, who would be born in Bethlehem, be anointed with the Holy Spirit, perform miracles of healing, and suffer and sacrifice Himself in atonement for sins.
