Lesson Enhancement Video: The Creed

- Start by discussing the Creed: **What was Peter, the narrator, talking about in this video?** (The Creed.)
 - **Why is the Creed important?** (Answers may include because it tells us the fundamental truths of our Catholic faith—what we believe and who we are—and it summarizes what God has done for us.)
 - Peter says that the Creed summarizes salvation history. **What is salvation history?** (The events, people, heroes, and villains that make up God's saving action in the world.)
- Invite students to reflect on what they've seen and heard in the video: **What are some moments or images that struck you when you watched this video?** (Answers may vary.)
 - **Why did these moments stick out to you?** (Answers may vary.)
 - **What are some of the truths presented in the Creed?** (Answers may include the Nativity, the Resurrection, the Blessed Trinity, and the Holy Spirit.)
- End by deepening the teaching point of the video: **Where do we profess the Creed together as a Church?** (At Mass on Sunday and other important solemnities and Holy Days of Obligation.)
 - **Why do we say the Creed on these days?** (To reaffirm our belief in the most important truths of our Catholic faith.)
 - Peter, the narrator, challenges us to accept the Creed, live it, witness to it, and share it with others. **Are you willing to do this?** (Answers may vary.)
 - **What parts of the Creed do you want to learn more about?** (Answers may include the Blessed Trinity, the resurrection of the dead, and the Church.)
