## Lesson Enhancement Video: Walking with God

- Start with the teaching point of the video: At the beginning of the video, we heard about Noah. *What did we learn about Noah from the video?* (That he walked with God.)
  - How should we be like Noah? (We should walk with God too.)
  - Should we walk with God in everything we do? (Yes.)
- Personalize the teaching point of the video: *When were some times the young boy in the video walked with God?* (Answers may include when he was grateful, when it was hard, when he was playing, and when he helped others.)
  - When do you walk with God? (Answers may vary.)
  - Can you walk with God when you are sad? (Yes. He is with me in my sadness.)
  - **Can you walk with God when you play with your friends?** (Yes. I praise God even when playing a game.)
  - **Does God walk with you?** (Yes, when I remain in His grace.)

## Small Wonders for Chapter 7: The Perch

**Lesson Link: Disobedience and consequences (Adam and Eve; Noah's generation).** Often the newness of something makes it easy to enjoy, but then the responsibilities become more difficult. Beginning with Adam and Eve, God's people often fell into sin. Because of this, God gave them rules to keep them safe and to maintain order within the human community. Disobeying the rules has consequences.

- Why did Tell-Tale the Mouse tell Trifles not to climb up to the perch? (Tell-Tale was afraid that Trifles might fall off or get hurt.)
- Why did Trifles disobey Tell-Tale? (He thought Tell-Tale might be hiding something she didn't want him to see.)
- How is this story like Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden? (Adam and Eve believed the serpent and thought God was hiding something from them. They thought they knew better than God.)
