# The Blessed Trinity

The Blessed Trinity is a perfect communion of love.

## Chapter Summary

The Blessed Trinity is one God in three Divine Persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit (see CCC 253). God is one—one in nature and in being. While the three Divine Persons of the Blessed Trinity always act as one, they carry out the divine work in salvation history in ways that are proper to each Person. God the Father is our Creator; God the Son is our Savior; and God the Holy Spirit is our Teacher and Comforter. When we share in the life of the Blessed Trinity, we are truly fulfilled and happy.

## More for Parents

Looking at our family lives and the blessings they give us, we may wonder why this life, though sometimes difficult, is so *satisfying*. Watching children grow and learn, we realize that the work we are doing gives us meaning and a sense of lasting happiness. We feel this way because we are made to give ourselves in love to others. We are made in the image of God, who is a communion of Persons who constantly give themselves to one another in love. The Father eternally gives Himself to the Son; the Son eternally gives Himself to the Father; and the Holy Spirit eternally proceeds from the Father and the Son, bringing the love of God to us. We are made for love.
