## **Discussion Questions**

• In this video, we saw the witness of a young missionary who spent a year serving the poor. His testimony reminds us that all humans are made in God's image and, therefore, have immense dignity. How does the witness of this young missionary inspire you to serve others and stand for human dignity?

- In the chapter, we read about the Christian virtue of solidarity, which empowers us to treat all people with charity
  and to respect the dignity of the outcast and marginalized. In the video, the young missionary modeled solidarity by
  developing genuine friendships with the people he served. Who in your life do you think God is calling you to show
  solidarity toward?
- In the video, the young missionary spoke about how serving people who suffer from "material" poverty revealed to him ways that he was suffering from "spiritual" poverty. He also spoke of the fact that most people suffer from a "poverty of loneliness," meaning they lack authentic friendships and community. In what ways can you bring support and friendship to those in your life who suffer from a "poverty of loneliness"?
