

Episode 1B: The Stranger

Run Time: 4:00

Suggested Viewing: After reading Chapter 5

Discussion Questions:

- This video opens on Good Friday and jumps forward to Sunday morning. Just before the stranger approaches the two disciples, we again hear a voice whispering the question, “Who do you say that I am?” **What might Cleopas have been thinking at this point (now the third day after Jesus’ Crucifixion)?**
 - You may wish to have students skim back through Luke 24:13–27 on page 70 of the Student Text to support their responses.
- Saint Luke tells us that the two disciples looked sad when approached by the stranger on the road (see Lk 24:17). **Why specifically were Cleopas and his companion (Symeon) sad? What details in this video help capture their sorrow and disappointment?**
- The Proclamation statement for Chapter 5 is a famous saying of Saint Jerome: “Ignorance of the Scriptures is ignorance of Christ.” **How does this video capture the same idea, namely, that all the Scriptures (even the ones in the Old Testament) reveal more fully who Jesus is?**
