Suggested Viewing: After reading Chapter 5

Discussion Questions:

- This video opens on Good Friday and jumps forward to Sunday morning. Just before the stranger approaches the two disciples, we again hear a voice whispering the question, "Who do you say that I am?" What might Cleopas have been thinking at this point (now the third day after Jesus' Crucifixion)?
 - You may wish to have students skim back through Luke 24:13–27 on page 70 of the Student Text to support their responses.
- Saint Luke tells us that the two disciples looked sad when approached by the stranger on the road (see Lk 24:17).
 Why specifically were Cleopas and his companion (Symeon) sad? What details in this video help capture their sorrow and disappointment?
- The Proclamation statement for Chapter 5 is a famous saying of Saint Jerome: "Ignorance of the Scriptures is ignorance of Christ." How does this video capture the same idea, namely, that all the Scriptures (even the ones in the Old Testament) reveal more fully who Jesus is?
